Clearly, the past four years has been a true ordeal for me, but because of your efforts I stand an excellent chance of correcting a terrible situation.

I was indicted on fourteen counts on January 8, 2003 in the Northern District of Ohio. I was convicted of a single count of wire fraud in March of 2004.



After trial, and only because of your efforts, my case never ended. Despite my conviction you did not quit on "our" case. You corresponded with me while I was away. You doggedly pursued those that perpetrated the "true fraud" in our case. We have now become the "hunters".

As a result of your efforts, my co-defendant and I stand at the threshold of getting our federal convictions overturned due to your post – trial persistence and discovery of withheld evidence.
